In the United States, the REAL ID Act of 2005 requires government agencies to capture accurate evidence of identity documents presented for driver licenses and state ID cards.

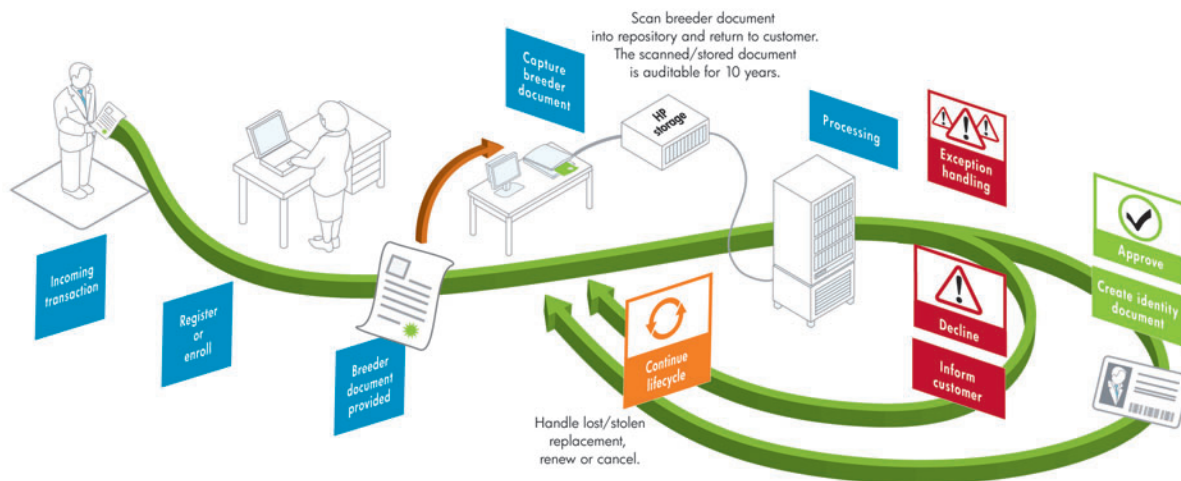

- A valid unexpired passport
- A certified copy of a birth certificate
- A consular report of birth abroad
- An unexpired permanent resident card
- An unexpired employment authorization document
- An unexpired foreign passport with valid visa affixed
- A certificate of citizenship
- A certificate of naturalization
- A national identity card

- **AccuRoute Image-In Point of Service software** to help manage the process of capturing paper and identification documents
- **AccuRoute Server** and the **AccuRoute Object Archive** to help process and store images captured through Image-In Point of Service
- **AccuRoute Embedded Device integration** for HP MFPs to allow the user to select specific scanning workflows for each capture scenario and each customer
- **AccuRoute ADT e-Forms** to help an organization define standardized forms and then merge specific transaction or customer data into those forms for distribution in printed or electronic formats
